

## Gosport DC9 & DC10 Planned Power Shutdown

---

Following on from the earlier postponed work by Scottish & Southern Electricity Networks, they have now provided a new date and given iomart notification that they will be carrying out essential maintenance works on 31<sup>st</sup> March. The maintenance will require a shutdown of the power supplies to the sites. As a result, both DC9 & DC10 will be running on generator supplies for the duration of the work.

### What will happen?

---

- 1: Pre-test – All systems will be checked and serviced to make sure all systems are running correctly.
  - 2: Power Supply to the site will be interrupted using a key switch and the site infrastructure will go through its process to transfer load onto generator. All systems will be checked and monitored
  - 3: The building load will be run on the generator for the duration of the SSE works and will be fully monitored throughout
  - 4: Power Supply will be re-instated and site infrastructure will revert onto mains power, and all systems will revert to normal state, a site check will be carried out to identify any issues or alarms
- Monitoring will continue to ensure there are no issues throughout the whole process.

### When will the work be carried out?

---

31<sup>st</sup> March 2026, the work window from 09.00 to 17.30

### Who will be completing the work?

---

The work will be carried out by iomart M&E Manager and electrical staff with the support of specialist contractors monitoring the UPS, AC & Generator Systems. All personnel will remain on-site during the work and carry out continuous monitoring throughout.

### Will I experience downtime?

---

As with any type of maintenance there is a risk of downtime, however this planned maintenance is not expected to be service affecting.
